Mezzo soprano

Fiona Campbell is widely regarded as one of Australia's finest singers. An accomplished international performer, recitalist and recording artist, Fiona was a winner of the ABC Young Performer of the Year Award and the Opera Awards, in the prestigious Australian Singing Competition.

Fiona has appeared as a principal artist with the Australian Chamber Orchestra, Australian Brandenburg Orchestra, Australia Ensemble, Australian String Quartet, Brodsky Quartet, Tokyo Philharmonic, Soloists of Royal Opera House Orchestra, Manchester Camerata, Odessa Philharmonic, Prague Chamber Orchestra, Hong Kong Philharmonic, Euro-Asian Philharmonic, Sydney Philharmonia, The Queensland Orchestra, Adelaide, Melbourne and West Australian Symphony Orchestras. Opera Australia, Opera North, Grange Park Opera, Glyndebourne Festival Opera, West Australian Opera, Opera Northern Ireland and Pinchgut Opera.

Fiona has received great critical acclaim for her portrayals of favourite operatic roles, such as Olga *Eugene Onegin*, Hansel *Hansel and Gretel*, Dorabella *Così fan Tutte*, Siebel *Faust*, Rosina *Il Barbiere di Siviglia*, Venus *Tannhäuser*, Ruggiero *Alcina*, Idamante *Idomeneo*, Vagaus *Juditha Triumphans*. and was nominated for a Helpmann Award this year for her Cherubino in *Le Nozze di Figaro*.

Her first solo album *Love, Loss, Lust*, is soon to be released internationally on the exclusive label MSM. Fiona has also recorded many recitals in Australia, broadcast by the ABC and her discography includes; *Early French Cantata's*, *Classic 100 Opera*, Mozart's *Idomeneo*, Vivaldi's *Juditha Triumphans*, *Just Classics 2*, all for ABC Classics.

Fiona sang with the legendary Jose Carreras in Tokyo last year and consequently was invited to be his guest artist in Australia, and then again in Korea, this year, in a series of Gala Concerts.

Future engagements include Symphony Under the Stars with renowned international soprano, Barbara Bonney, followed by a concert tour with her in Korea and Japan. In 2010 Fiona will appear with the ACO, on their national tour of Bach and Beyond.
